Telcom Enterprises conducted a comprehensive review of our land lines, long distance, and telephone maintenance contracts to offer any efficiencies and potential cost savings for the Corporation of the County of Huron in 2005.

Telcom Enterprises are very knowledgeable with respect to Bell Canada Services and as a result of the review, Telcom Enterprises were able to significantly reduce the County of Huron's telecom costs. In particular we switched most of our Bell Canada lines to Allstream lines provided through Bell Canada. Significant monthly savings have been achieved for the eighty eight lines that have been converted between Clinton and Goderich, Ontario.
